Content

Pick either a *fictional* book or a film. Provide a very brief summary of the piece. In other words, tell us the plot of the book or film. Also, describe any significant characters, settings, scenes, etc. In addition, rate the quality of the film in comparison to others like it.

For example, if you picked the film *Iron Man*, you might summarize *Iron Man*. Then, explain the similarities and differences of *Iron Man* to movies in the same type of genre (Comic Adaptations), such as *Batman*, *The Hulk*, *Hancock*, *Fantastic Four*, and others.

In terms of quality, you might discuss qualities associated with books (level of sophistication, ease of reading, length, quality of descriptions, characters, settings, etc.). If you choose a film, you might discuss other facets, such as length, quality of acting, use of color, use of light and darkness, camera angles, movement of the camera, special effects, makeup, dress/clothing/costumes, dialogue, quality of story/plot, and even some extraordinary things such as awards won, critical praise, or the quality of soundtracks/scores things.

You should attempt to use some quoted or paraphrased material from the source.. In addition, you are welcome to use additional secondary sources to point to critical praise or other special nuances. At the very least, cite the film and any films used in comparison.
