Choose one of the following prompts:

1. Choose a time when you stood up for your beliefs. Your narrative should show the readers why you decided to make that stand and try to give specifics on how you felt after the primary events.
2. Think of a time when you disagreed with a decision and took action to change someone else's mind.
3. Forget yourself for a minute, and focus on something you witnessed happening to others which changed you. Narrate the event and help explain how the event was significant in changing you.
4. Create a rant. Go on a tirade. Discuss something in your own words which happens on a regular basis or has happened (in history) which you do not like, which seems unfair, or which really puts you in a bind.
5. Create a commendation/tribute. Discuss something or someone in your life which makes life much better for you or others. Point to a specific instances where this person, place, or thing made a difference.
