Underline the Adjuncts in the following sentences.

1. Motorcycles are for people who live on the edge of life.
2. However, people on motorcycles seem small compared to cars like ants to shoes. (Manner)
3. Motorcycles often rush uninhibited past trucks and cars at intense speeds. (Manner)
4. If a motorist see a motorcycle coming they make sure to move slightly to avoid a collision. (Conditional)
5. Motorcyclists often take advantage of the opening so they can pass quickly (Purpose)
6. Oftentimes, Motorcyclists forget that motorists voluntarily move out of the way mostly out of courtesy (Cause)
7. If a motorcyclist is passing a distracted driver he or she might be injured or killed. (Conditional)
8. Distracted drivers might not see the motorcyclist when he or she passes (Time/Temporal)
