## **CONFUSING WORDS WORKSHEET #1**

**accept** means to agree to something or to receive something willingly. **except** means to exclude or omit. As a preposition, except means *but* or *excluding*.

**all ready** means that all are ready. **already** means previously or before now.

**capital** is a city; or an adjective meaning excellent, most serious, or most important. **capitol** is a building in which a state legislature meets. **the Capitol** is the building in Washington, D.C., in which the United States Congress meets.

**desert (n)** means a wilderness or dry, sandy region with sparse vegetation. **desert (v)** means to abandon or receiving a just reward **dessert** is a sweet served at the end of a meal.

**hear** means to listen to, or take notice of. **here** means in this place.

**its** is a word that indicates ownership or possession. **it's** is a contraction for *it is* or *it has*.
