

LIST OF COMMON ADVERBS

When?

yesterday	always	early
today	never	late
tomorrow	often	earlier
now	seldom	later
once	frequently	soon
usually	sometimes	occasionally

Where?

here	in	north
there	out	south
somewhere	up	home
nowhere	down	east
everywhere	upstairs	west
anywhere	downstairs	near

Why?

This group includes weakened phrases and clauses beginning with words like *since* and *because*.

How?

quickly	fast	commonly
slowly	well	noisily
easily	slow	narrowly
carefully	slowly	

Under What Condition?

Phrases and clauses beginning with words like *if*

not	maybe	certainly
also	possibly	perhaps
too	doubtlessly	nearly
probably	almost	mostly

Note that some adverbs in “when” and “how” lists, like early, late, earlier, later, fast, and slow can also be used as adjectives.

Fast as an adverb

Mary drives fast.

Fast as an adjective

Mary is fast.
